This week we have been learning...

- \* to write the story of the Three Little Pigs using story language (suddenly, unfortunately, luckily...) using a story plan that we created
- \* the structure of a story - beginning, build up, dilemma, resolution and ending
- \* to recognise the place value of numbers from 10 to 99, partitioning numbers into tens and ones. E.g. 24 is 2 tens and 4 ones.
- \* to compare and group materials based on the properties - bendy/not bendy, shiny/dull, stretchy/stiff and waterproof/not waterproof
- \* to carry out a fair test on the properties of everyday materials to see if they are waterproof

## For home learning you can...

Compare and group materials around the home that are shiny/dull or stretchy/stiff

Practice finding 2 digit numbers and telling someone the value of each digit in that number

Read more fairytales to gain inspiration for your own fairytale that you will be creating next week.
