This week we have been learning...

## Phonics learning

In Kirsty's group we have been recapping the phase 3 digraphs /or/ and /ar/. We are also reading and writing the tricky words **was** and **my**.

In Ashleigh's group we have been recapping the phase 5 sounds /ay/ - tray, /ou/ - cloud and /ie/- cried.

In Peggy's group we have moved on to Phase 5 high frequency words. We are reading and writing **house**, **about**, **day** and **boy** and revising the sounds 'ay', 'oy' and 'ou'.

In Nyashia's group we are reviewing alternative pronunciations of graphemes learnt. We are also learning alternative spellings for /ai/ - eigh, ey, ay, a and a\_e. We will practice reading and writing those words in sentences.
