Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to Kilmorie. Year 1 has got off to a flying start with us all getting to know each other. We have spent time deciding on those all important school and classroom rules we all need to keep us happy throughout the year. This term our topic is called **5,4,3,2,1, Blast Off!** and is a history based topic. We will be learning about the first people in Space, the Moon Landing and last year's space exploration by the famous British Astronaut Tim Peake.

Our learning

In **Literacy** we will be reading **Beegu, Aliens love Underpants** and **Man on the Moon** as well as other space-based stories. In **Maths** we are focusing on number, ordering and ensuring all our children are confident with their number bonds to five and ten. We also aim for all children to be secure with reading and writing numerals from 0 to 20.

As always **reading** and **writing** are very important, so please read with your children every day and try to encourage them to write about things that interest them e.g. letters, postcards, shopping lists, stories etc. By the end of next week, all our children will be issued with a new **Reading Record Book** which we will use to maintain a weekly dialogue between school and the parents to boost your child's reading progress throughout the year. If your child has mislaid their book bag please let the office know and they will issue your child with a new one.

Please note that our indoor **PE** time will be on **Thursday**. Our outdoor PE time will be on **Monday**. Please ensure that your child brings their **PE kit** to school on these days.

PE kit: Comfortable, well fitting trainers or pumps, shorts and a t-shirt for indoor PE. Leggings/tracksuit bottoms and a t-shirt for outdoor PE. A sweatshirt will be needed for when it gets cooler.

We are really looking forward to all of the learning opportunities to come. We can't wait to get busy creating some amazing work this term. Here's to some happy Yr 1 learning!
