CONTACT INFORMATION Please could all parents ensure the school is aware of any changes to emergency telephone numbers, including contact numbers for those who are taking charge of your children at the end of the day. SUN SAFETY As the weather begins to change please ensure children arrive at school armed with a hat (named), sunscreen applied, water bottles (refillable), inhalers and hayfever/travel sickness medication has been taken before school. This is particularly important when children are going on school trips.

SANDALS Be mindful of safety when choosing footwear as children run around a lot! Footwear must hold feet firmly in place and any open toe sandals or footwear need to have secure fasteners.
