

Year Two Home Learning Autumn 2, Week 2 22.09.17

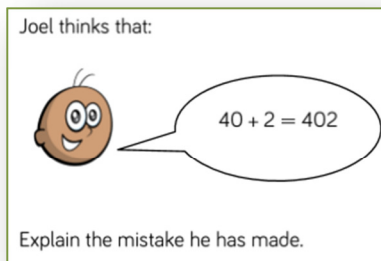
This week we have
been learning...

- learning to use noun phrases.

If sun is the noun, a noun phrase is a way of giving more information about the sun.

- learning how to partition (to separate) 2 digit numbers into tens and ones using objects and drawings

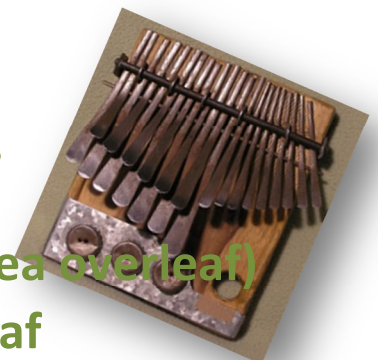


We use this understanding to prove the value of numbers in order to solve problems
