This week we have been

- going 352 years back in time for our new topic – *The Plague of 1665*

What other facts can you find out about life for Londoners during the time of the plague?

acting out gruesome scenes from the filthy London streets and using this to inspire our sentence writing

Take somebody down your imaginary street with you.
Describe to them what you can see, hear, touch and smell.

- finding evidence from historic maps to show how London has changed over time since the Romans nearly 2000 years ago

Ask an older person/relative to describe what their street/town was like when they were a child – what has changed since then?

- solving addition and subtraction calculations and problems using a number line

$$34 + 4 = ?$$

Teach somebody at home how to use an empty number line to add and subtract.

- experimenting with different rolls, jumps and spins in gymnastics and creating routines with these movements
