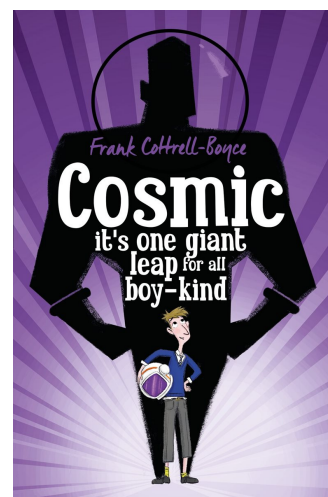


Year 5 Spring 1 Newsletter 2018
