This week we have been revising the digraphs **sh**, **ch**, **th** and **ng**. We have also learnt the tricky word was.

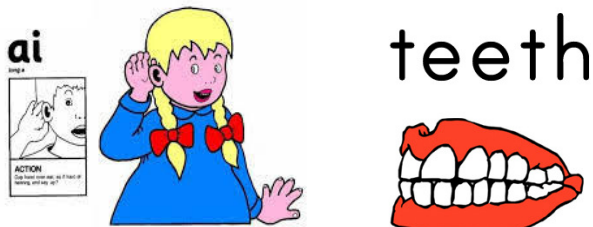


Jacky

We have been focusing on measuring weight using our hands, balances and the challenge of our eyes. We have found objects in the classroom that are heavier/lighter than something else. We have used comparative language such as heavier, lighter, lightest, heaviest etc.

Next week we will be looking at capacity.

- Order your fruit or vegetables from lightest to heaviest
- Predict how many cups it will take to fill a variety of containers using pourable materials such as rice, water etc.
- Use the language full, half full and empty
