## KEEPING KILMORIE CHILDREN SAFE

It is important that the school is provided with up to date contact information for parents, carers, as well as emergency contacts and anyone you have arranged to collect on your behalf. This is particularly important if we need to get hold of you in an emergency. We have recently been unable to make contact with some parents.

Yesterday Dominic's class did an assembly based on their topic '1066 and All That'. It was a very well planned and performed assembly. I was particularly impressed by their confidence and good public speaking skills. Congratulations to all of Dominic's class!

On Monday evening the orchestra performed at Goldsmith's along with many other schools as part of the Lewisham Live Festival. There were 36 children in the Kilmorie orchestra and they played Vivaldi's Autumn and Winter. I was very proud of them all.

Quite often we receive complaints from neighbours to the school about parents parking over their driveways or generally being inconsiderate about parking. **PARKING IN FRONT OF DRIVEWAYS** We have had several very irate complaints again about cars which are left parked in front of residents driveways and 2 in just the last 2 days! Some of the driveways may look like they are not in use but wherever possible please, please, please can parents **avoid** parking in front of residents' driveways in Kilmorie Road and Vancouver Road (including the part of Vancouver Road which leads to a public pathway). There are clearly spaces which would not obstruct driveways so please do check before you walk away from your car or try other nearby roads including Elsinore Road!
