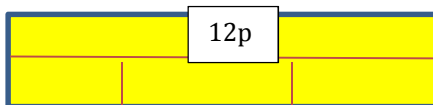

For example - try looking at a thermometer, a measuring jug, the volume dial on an amplifier, the thermostat dial on the heater...

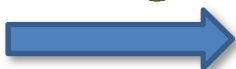
- using apparatus to perform a sequence of balances, turns and jumps
