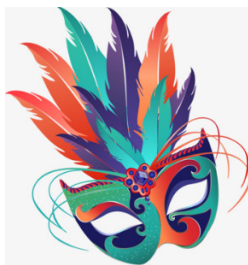




The Friends of Kilmorie promote positive relationships within the school community by organising social events and fundraising for additional resources.
