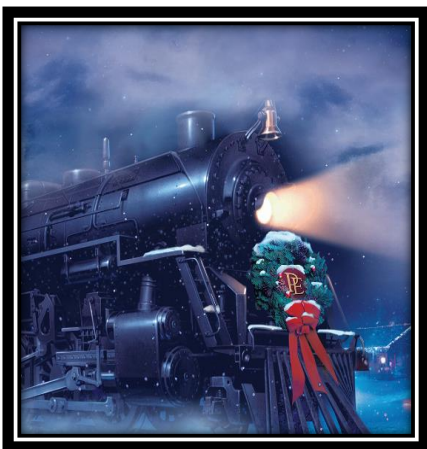


Hunters Estate Agents are the official sponsors of the 2018 Kilmorie Christmas Fair.

DONATIONS STILL NEEDED!

A huge thank you to everyone who has donated so far! We are taking donations until the day before the fair, but the sooner you can get things to us, the more time we will have to sort through them. All donations can be left at the school office. We're particularly in need of more of the following items:

- * **Jingle jars** - we still need plenty of these! Ask your kids to decorate empty jam jars, fill them with stuff that kids like (stickers, wrapped sweets, stationery, little toys etc.) and they will be sold on the Jingle Jar stall with all money raised going to a charity chosen by the School Council.
- * **Soft toys** - washed and dried for our very popular 'Find A Friend' stall.
- * **Silver coins** (no coppers) for our Money Tree - the game will be over very quickly if we don't get some more!
- * **White fairy lights** - in working order, either battery or mains operated, so we can make the school look beautiful and twinkly. We are happy to take donations of fairy lights, or if you have some you're willing to lend but need back, please label them with your name and we will return them to you afterwards.
- * **Cardboard** - large pieces of card or cardboard to make signs.
- * **White fabric/material** - e.g. sheets etc. for decorations.
- * **Large carpet inner tube** - just in case anyone has had a new carpet recently, we could really do with a tube from inside a carpet roll!
- * **Blankets or throws** - for people to keep warm at our outside bar area (please ensure they are labelled if you need them back).
- * **White paper snowflakes** – do you remember making snowflakes with white paper and scissors as a child? We need lots of these to decorate the school. Why not make some with your kids?
