A simple noun phrase is where an adjective comes before a noun. For example, *tall giraffe*.

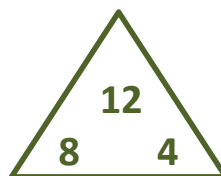
Can you see the running, tall giraffe?
