This week we have been learning.....

For home learning, you can...

- * Go for a walk and talk about the seasonal changes that you notice.

Phonics

In Sophie's group we have been learning the split digraphs u-e (eg june, cube) e-e (eg extreme), revising other digraphs to date and teaching spelling of some, come, were, there.

In Sarah and Fiona's group this week we have been learning contractions (I'm doesn't, don't) and learning to read 'through' and 'though'.

In Naomi's group we have been learning the digraph /ey/ (eg keys), and tricky words: like, were. We have also been reviewing all other phase 5 digraphs to date.

In Rez's group we have been learning the sound **ow** as in cow, town, how and the sound **oi** as in coin, soil, point.

In Leela's group we have been revising phase four, focusing on the cvcc words such as milk, help, went gust. We have also been practising the 'pl' sound as in planet, plum, plug and plant.

We will be very busy over the next 2 weeks, so will not be doing any group reading across year 1, so will just be changing children's books during this time.
