This week we have been:

Phonics

In Sophie's group we have been learning the alternative pronunciation for /a/ (bath, tap, bacon, want), /y/ (yes, sky, myth, smelly), ch (chick, school, chef) and writing phase 5 tricky words learnt to date.

In Sarah and Fiona's group this week we have been learning the alternative pronunciation for /c/ (cat, acid), /g/ (got, gin), /ey/ (money, they) and practicing our tricky words little, one, do, what, out. We have also been thinking about contractions- I'm (I am).

In Naomi's group we have been practising all phase 5 sounds to date and reading real and alien words with phase 5 sounds in.

In Leela's group we have been practising reading and identifying words beginning with 'pl' (planet/plank), 'pr' (printer/prompt), 'fl' (flower/flan) and 'fr' (fringe/frog). We have also been learning about words with more than one syllable such as 'lunchbox', 'windmill' and 'handbag'.

In Rez's group we have been learning short sentences with CCVC words (brick, black, click, crab) We have also been reviewing our phase 3 digraphs
