Phonics

In Naomi's phonics group we have been continuing to revise all of the phase 5 sounds to date. We have also been reading real and alien words.

In Sophie's phonics group we have been learning alternative spellings of 'ai', (hay, bake, eight), alternative spelling of 'c' (queen, box, school, lick, kit, cat). Reading tricky words: said, so, have, like, some, come, were, who.

In Fiona and Sarah's phonics group we have been learning alternative spellings for 'n' (knife, gnome) 'r' (wrap) 's' (listen, house, nice, scent) 'z' (blouse), revising high frequency words and common exception words

In Leela's group we have been learning alternative spellings of 'ai' (stay, play, spray), 'ow' (cloud, mouth, south) and 'igh' (cried, tie, fried). We have also been practicing the tricky words: oh, people, their.

In Rez's phonics group this week, we have been learning the digraphs 'ew' (stew, drew, grew) 'oy' (toy, joy, boy) and the digraph 'ay' (day, say, play).
