Next week on Friday 15th March we will be supporting Comic Relief Red Nose Day. Children can choose to wear red, something funny and red noses! We will be shaking our buckets at the start and end of the day to collect donations for Comic Relief.

WORLD BOOK DAY Many children, parents and carers enjoyed sharing a book at our wonderful Booky Breakfast, thanks to all who came and donated! All of the children from reception to year 6 joined in with a retelling of 'We're going on a bear hunt' in their costumes and pyjamas in assembly today and each class had a surprise storyteller come to share a story with them in the afternoon! Do not forget to take your World Book Day book voucher to your local bookstore where you can swap it for one of twelve fantastic World Book Day books, or put it towards any other book you may fancy.

REMINDER ABOUT KEEPING YOUR CHILDREN SAFE ON THE INTERNET

- Talk to them about what they are doing – they will enjoy teaching you.
- Make sure that they know the people they communicate with online whom they don't know are strangers. Children do not equate that people they have conversations with online when playing games are strangers.
- Make sure children know what to do if something they see or something someone says makes them feel uncomfortable – they need to tell you.
- Make sure they know that things they share on the internet can potentially be shared. Children can feel anonymous online and forget that photos, conversations, video clips, etc., can often be viewed by others.

Remember

- Most social media sites have a lower age limit of 13 years. We are aware that many of our children access these (including WhatsApp, Instagram and YouTube). If you have allowed them access it is really important that you monitor what they do and ideally do not allow them to post images or videos of themselves without your permission.
