### WANT TO HELP BUT DON'T HAVE MUCH TIME?

Events are great fun, bring the school community together and raise important funds – but if you don't have time to volunteer, there are lots of other easy ways you can raise money for the school:

- Find out if your employer has a Payroll Giving / Give As You Earn scheme – this allows you to make regular payroll payments to UK charities of your choice. The donation is made from your gross pay, which means it goes further and saves you tax. You can choose how much you want to donate each month and which UK charity to support. Friends of Kilmorie's charity number is 1033770.
- Look into matched funding - many larger employers will match funds raised by staff when they volunteer in their own time for a charity (usually up to a set limit). For example, if a parent volunteers on a stall at an event which makes £500, the parent's employer would then match this amount with a further £500.
- Sign up to easyfundraising - earn money for the PTA whenever you shop online with popular retailers. Go to [www.easyfundraising.org.uk/causes/friendsofkilmorie](http://www.easyfundraising.org.uk/causes/friendsofkilmorie) to register.
