This week we have applying our knowledge of different punctuation to a range of sentences, exclamations and questions. **What does this sentence need on the end _____**

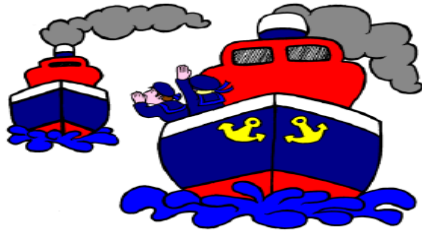
Jacky
