In Sarah and Fiona's group we have been revising all alternative pronunciations and common exception words learnt this half term.

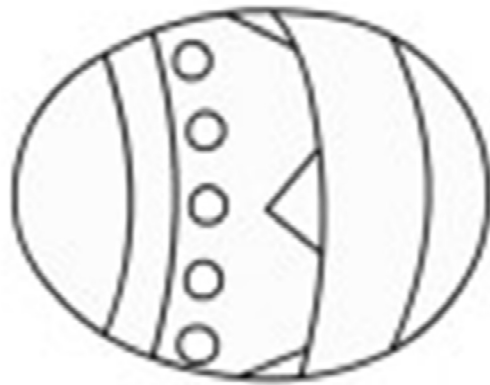
In Naomi's group we have been reading two syllable words and recapping all phase 5 sounds and practising real and alien words.
