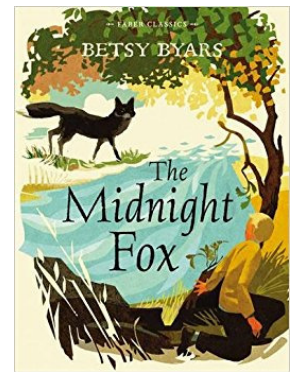


Year 5 Summer 2 Newsletter 2018
