**SCHOOL MEAL PRICE INCREASE** In case you missed the notification sent out last week, the cost of a primary school meal increased as of 1<sup>st</sup> May 2019 from £2.10 to £2.30 per meal. The amended costs for this term are therefore:

**Summer first half term (23<sup>rd</sup> April to 24<sup>th</sup> May) £52.90**  
**Summer second half term (3<sup>rd</sup> June to 23<sup>rd</sup> July) £82.80**  
**Summer full term (23<sup>rd</sup> April to 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2019) £135.70**

If you have already paid for the half or full term, please could you settle the difference on ParentPay accordingly.

**PACKED LUNCHES** A reminder that packed lunches from home should not contain items such as M&Ms, chocolate nut bars, sweets, pesto – all these items contain nuts which goes against advice to not bring into school products containing nuts – a key aspect of safeguarding children with allergies. Likewise, it is advisable for children not to share their food with other children. Please speak to your child about when it is good to share and when it can be unsafe.

A healthy packed lunch can include starchy foods like bread, rice or pasta, protein foods such as meat, fish, eggs or beans, a dairy product like cheese or yogurt, vegetables or salad and a portion of fruit, a biscuit or a wafer and a sugar free drink. **We are now also a Sugar Smart school!**
