INSTRUMENTAL LESSONS 2019-20 The application form for instrumental lessons 2019-20 is now live on the website. If you have already applied and your child has not yet been given a place then they are on the list for September and you do not need to apply again. September places will be confirmed during the last couple of weeks of this term.

SUN SAFETY As the weather begins to change please ensure children arrive at school armed with a hat (named), sunscreen applied, water bottles (refillable), inhalers and hayfever/travel sickness medication has been taken before school. This is particularly important when children are going on school trips.

SANDALS Be mindful of safety when choosing footwear as children run around a lot! Footwear must hold feet firmly in place and any open toe sandals or footwear need to have secure fasteners. So please, no flip flops or strappy sandals that can flop up and down and cause a child to trip (for example crocs).

MISSING ITEM A navy Kilmorie school book bag belonging to Cai in Year 2 has been missing for nearly 3 weeks from Wrap Around Care. It contains his black teddy, books with his name on and a letter C keyring. Please could everyone check at home in case it has been picked up by mistake, or if you spot it, please return it to the school or Wrap Around office.

SAFETY IN THE PLAYGROUND For safety reasons please can parents support the school by adhering to the following rules before and after school:

- When coming into or going out of school, the main gate **must** be shut firmly after you. This is particularly important at the end of the day when children are being collected from clubs. We all have a duty to keep our school safe.
- Some visitors tailgate a parent/visitor who has been officially admitted into school. Please could parents be cautious as to who is following them in and ensure that they are directed to the school reception.
- Children should not be riding scooters and bicycles in the playground.
- The climbing frame in the main playground and play equipment in the Yr1 playground is for use during school time only (9-3.30pm).

Please help us to maintain safety in the playground and keep the children safe.
