

Yr3 Learning Letter – Thursday 20th June 2019
Valerie's Class

English

The children have been resilient in their learning to write sentences with varied starters and using inverted commas to report speech. Their learning focus included:

- Punctuate speech correctly and include an interesting reporting clause either at the start or the end of the sentence, e.g. Mary screamed, "Help! My foot is trapped!" or "Help! My foot is trapped!" screamed Mary.
- Write reported speech as direct speech, e.g. Miss Hull said that we were very noisy today. "You are very noisy Elephant Class!" moaned Miss Hull.
- Use varying starters to write interesting sentences.



Maths

In maths the children continued to practice solving 2-digit multiplied by 1-digit word problems using the formal expanded column method, ensuring that the digits were neatly recorded in the correct place value, e.g. 62×4

Their success criteria were:

- partition a 2 digit number into 10's and 1s
- input my calculation correctly using the expanded method.
- multiply the 1's and then the 10's
- add my answers together to find the solution.
- solve problems about 2-digit multiplied by one digit calculations.

The children continued to practice solving problems using their reasoning skills, e.g.

When Stu calculated the question 27×3 , his answer was 6021. What mistake has he made?

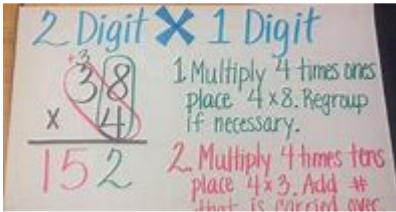
