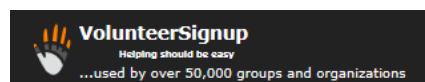

Last Minute Donations Needed!

Thanks to everyone who has donated. There are a few things we still need – please bring to the office by Friday morning if possible.

- **Bottles** – we have enough alcohol for the bottle tombola, but would still like some more donations of other types of unopened, in date bottles – soft drinks, bubble bath, olive oil, vinegar, shampoo, cleaning products etc.
- **Chapter books** – fiction chapter books or early reader books for older children (5-11) only please! No picture books, baby/toddler/pre-school or adult books.
- **Coins** – lots more coins are needed for the money tree or else it won't run (no coppers, 5p and upwards only).
- **Plastic bottles** – clean with lids, 500mls or smaller.
