INSTRUMENTAL LESSONS/BORROWED INSTRUMENTS All instrument lessons ended on **MONDAY 15th JULY**. Please can leavers with borrowed instruments leave their instrument in their teaching room either after their last lesson or exam. Children who are continuing with lessons in September should take their instruments home for the holidays. **Please note that instrument lessons automatically continue in the autumn unless you give notice to stop before September 1st.** All instrument lessons resume from **MONDAY 23rd SEPTEMBER**.

NEW APPLICATIONS FOR INSTRUMENT LESSONS All new applications for instrument lessons have now been acknowledged, please get in touch with the school office if you have applied and not heard anything. Fees have been uploaded to Parent Pay and are due by September 30th. Only piano lesson deposits need to be paid by the end of this term.

ENRICHMENT CLUBS... ended for the summer term on **MONDAY 15th JULY** and resume in the autumn from **MONDAY 23rd SEPTEMBER**. All Autumn clubs have now been confirmed on your Parent Pay accounts and the payment deadline was midday on **TUESDAY, 16TH JULY**. Places will be offered to the waiting list where no payment has been received.

DINNER MONEY FOR NEXT TERM The cost of meals for the first half of next term (4/9/19 to 18/10/19) will be £75.90. Please deduct the amount of £11.50 if your child is going on school journey in September. The cost for the second half (28/10/19 to 19/12/19) will be £89.70. Payment should be made via ParentPay.

HEALTH ADVICE There has been a recent outbreak of measles in Southwark and cases linked in both Lewisham and Lambeth. Measles is a very infectious viral illness that spreads by coughs and sneezes, and can be a serious infection for some people. Symptoms include fever, sore red eyes and rash. Measles can spread easily from someone who is infected. To minimise spread to children and their families, the Health Authority's advice is that you seek guidance from your family doctor should your child develop a rash illness, to telephone ahead before attending general practice, urgent Care Centres or the Emergency Department and to report to reception on arrival.

REMINDERS FOR START OF AUTUMN TERM SEPTEMBER 2019

1. If your child is currently in year 2, you will no longer be eligible for the universal free school meal entitlement. Payment can be made on Parent Pay. If you do not have a login, please collect one from the office. The cost of a primary meal is £2.30 per day.

If you are eligible for free school meals please visit our website <http://www.kilmorieschool.co.uk/parents/school-dinners/> to complete an application with the local authority, or via the Lewisham website <https://schools.lewisham.gov.uk/parentportal/>.

2. **Free School Meals** Please can parents ensure that you apply for all siblings if your circumstances have changed and inform Pupil Support if your child is transferring to secondary school.

3. **School Website** – please remember to change your year group news subscription on the website as your child moves year group.

4. If your child is moving into Y5 or Y6 in September and you would like them to walk home independently, please complete a permission to walk home form, if you have not already done so. The form is available from the school office.

5. Please update the school with change of address and contact number, including those that take charge of your children in your absence.

SECONDARY TRANSFER This is the time to be looking around at secondary schools if your child is currently in year 5/transferring to year 6 in September. An information booklet has been sent home with your child today and also available on school websites and the local authority website www.lewisham.gov.uk and we have today sent home with your child an information booklet for parents. All applications have to be made online at www.eadmissions.org.uk by **31st October 2019** but we recommended that you submit your online form by **18th October 2019**.

SECONDARY ADMISSIONS COFFEE MORNING Lewisham are running an informal coffee morning for parent and carers about to embark on the secondary admissions process to give parents an opportunity to learn more about the process. You will have to register for this event using the link below. This event will be at the Civic Suite on **Saturday 7th September 10am-12.30pm**. There will be staff and pupil representatives present from each Lewisham secondary school so parents and carers can feel informed about each school and perhaps visit some during the open days that you might not have known about.
