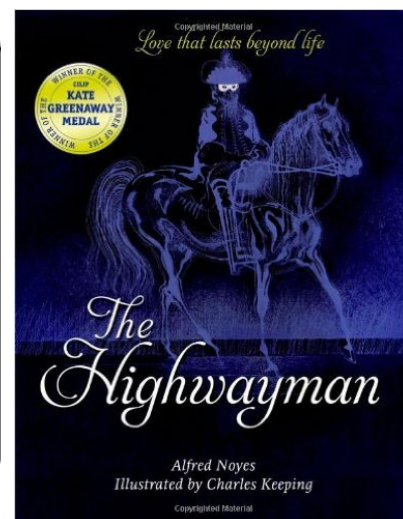


Year 5 Autumn 1 Newsletter 2019
