Next clap your hands in time to each word you say.

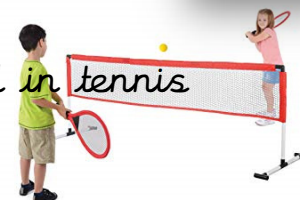
Now do this with somebody else to teach them the difference.
