The children demonstrated their good understanding and understood the relevance of school initiatives such as recycling, walking to school, turning engines off and not wasting electricity.

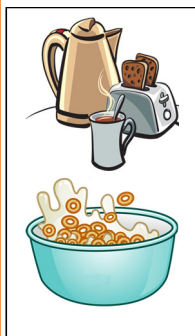

HARVEST FESTIVAL This school year we are collecting donations in aid of the Lewisham Food Bank. The food will be distributed to help people in crisis in Lewisham who have been referred to the Lewisham Foodbank and also to other nearby foodbanks or partner organisations, e.g. homeless projects or where there are shortages.

Items needed urgently are:

Fruit Juice (long life)	Toilet Paper
Tinned meat (not pork)	Toiletries
Coffee	Sugar

Due to people's generosity, they have plenty of pasta, tomatoes, beans, soup, tea and cereals.

You can also donate non-food items such as

- Personal hygiene items, toilet paper, soap, shampoo, toothpaste, deodorant, sanitary towels
- Soap powder, detergent, washing up liquid
- Kitchen items: can openers, cooking utensils (in useable condition)

There will be a box in the school reception to collect your contributions. All non-perishable, in-date donations will be gratefully received.

(Please do not donate food which is out of date or past its 'use by' or 'best before' date.)
