For home learning, you can...


- * Tell your adult your number bonds to 10! Use the Part Part Whole template on the back of this letter to show your number bonds.

In Sophie's group we have been learning compound words such as starlight and revising all Phase 4 including the tricky words ready to begin Phase 5.


