



Year Two Home Learning Autumn 1, Week 5 04.10.19

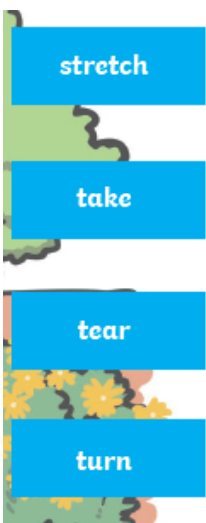
We enjoyed exploring the woodland habitats and identifying trees on our trip to Sydenham Woods.

- learning how to use **time conjunctions** and **imperative verbs** to write clear instruction for how to make a mask

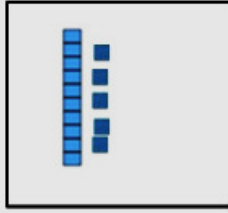
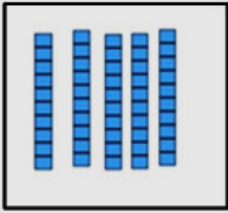
