Phonics

In Sophie's group we have been learning phase 5 sounds 'ue' as in rescue and glue, 'aw' as in paw and 'wh' as in when, 'ph' as in dolphin.

In Sarah's group this week we have been learning the split digraphs e_e as in these, u_e as in huge and learning the tricky words some, come, were, there.

In Stephanie's group we have been learning to read and write two syllable words : lunchbox, desktop, treetop and learning the tricky words: were, there, little, one.

In Rez's group we have been recapping the sound **ee, er, igh**. We practised writing the tricky words **they, was, all**.

In Leela's group we have been revising sounds ai (rain, pain), ee (feet, sheep), igh (night, light). We have also been practising tricky words 'was' and 'my'.
