### Phonics

In Sophie's group we have been learning the alternative spelling of the sound 'au' as in launch the split digraph sounds i-e as in smile and revising tricky words 'some', 'come', were

In Sarah's group this week we have been learning alternate pronunciations for the following graphemes- ie (pie or chief), ow (down or low) and ea (sea or head) and spelling the common exception words 'where' 'who' 'water' and 'again'.

In Stephanie's group we have been learning the graphemes ay (day), ou (out), ie (cried), ea (eat) and practising tricky words: people, their, oh.

In Leela and Rez's groups we have been learning 'igh' and 'or' and reviewing tricky words some, come.

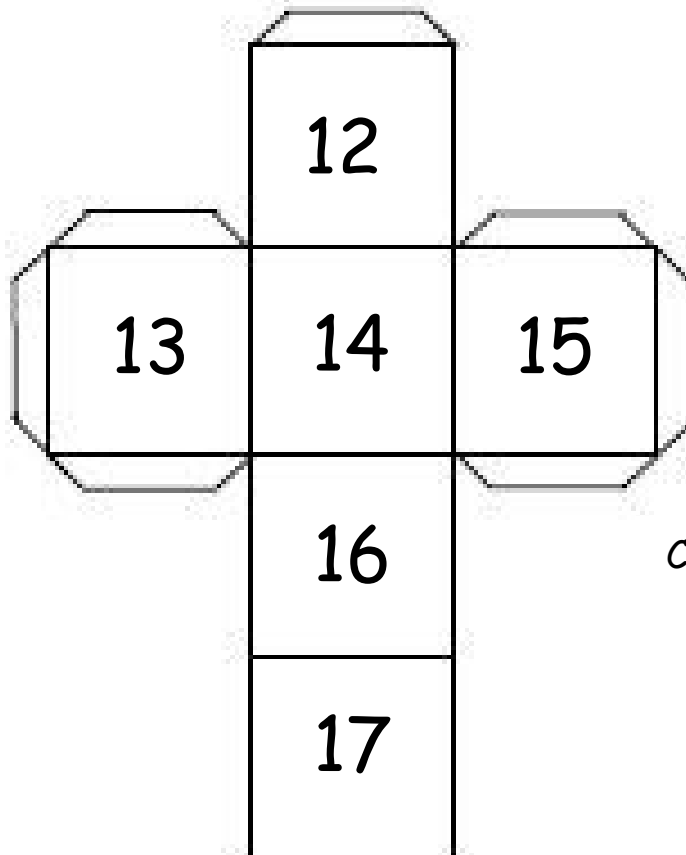
