



This week we have been learning.....

- * to listen to and retell the story of The Three Little Pigs
- * to write character thought/ speech bubbles from different scenes from The Three Little Pigs, remembering to use The Fab Five.
- * to use a ten frame to find different ways to take away

For home learning, you can...

- * Retell the story of The Three Little Pigs to an adult using your own teddy bears or toys
- * Be teacher for the day and teach your adult The Fab Five and how to take away using numbers below 10
- * Make your own ten frame and find 10 different objects from your home or garden to practise subtracting.

Phonics

In Sophie's group we have been learning ie, as in fried, ea as in meat and oy as in boy. We have also been reviewing tricky words.

In Sarah's group this week we have been learning to read and write phase 5 sounds /au/ (e.g. caught), /oe/ (e.g. doe, goes) and /ey/ (e.g. donkey).

In Stephanie's group we have been reviewing cvcc words, for example: damp, tent, went, jump, sand, land and learning to read and write the tricky words: said, so.

In Leela's group we have been practising our phase three sounds; ch (chop, chin), sh (shin, shark) and th (that, moth). We have also been writing sentences with the tricky words 'we, me and be'.

In Rez's group we have been learning the phase 3 sound "ai" as in chair, sail, rain... as well as phase three tricky words.
