Home learning


 Encourage playing as shops and using money – familiarity with giving and exchanging coins, the use of language such as change, pound, penny and any coin/note denomination is useful. Maybe let them do the transaction in a shop or to sort coins by shape/colour/value?

Phonics


This week we have been learning about the graphemes **h**, **b**, **f/ff**, **I/II**, blending them in words such as bell/huff/hot/bag. We learn the double letters of **ff** and **II** at the same time, as their sound is the same. We introduce **ss** later as **s** is the first sound they learn and it could get confusing! Get your child to show you these as practise. We have also been reading the tricky words **I**, **the**, **to**, **no** and **go**. We use this song to support this learning.


