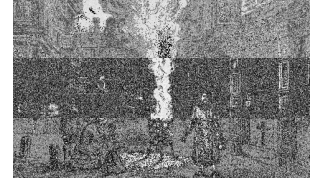

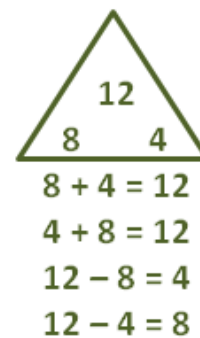
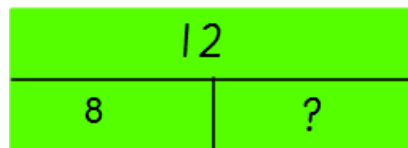
- finding out more about *The Plague*, writing about it and extending the sentences we write using conjunctions

- making decorations for our Christmas hoops to hang in the hall ready for the 'Twelve Days of Christmas' fair.



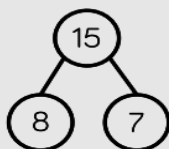
