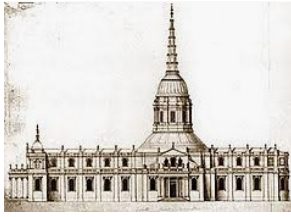


On Thursday we had a wonderful time on our trip to St Paul's Cathedral and learned how the buildings in London have changed since 1666.
