What other facts can you find out about life for Londoners during the time of the plague?

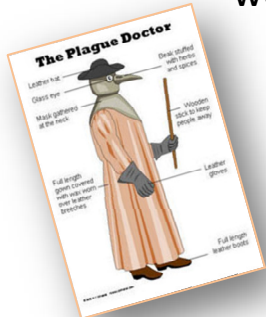
- we acted out gruesome scenes from the filthy London streets and using this to inspire our sentence writing
