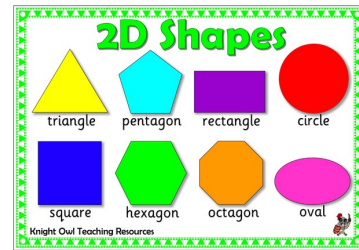


Year One Home Learning Week 6.12.19



This week we have been.....

- * learning the names and properties of 2D shapes.

For home learning, you can...

Phonics

In Sophie's group we have been learning the split digraphs o-e (eg bone, explode) a-e (eg shake, amaze), revising other digraphs to date and learning the tricky words would, should and could.

In Sarah's group this week we have been learning to read and write the words 'laughed' and 'because'. Tell your adult the way we remember to spell because! We have also been looking at the different pronunciations for 'a' (e.g. fast, acorn, cat) and 'y' (e.g. yes, bicycle, funny).

In Stephanie's group we have been learning the digraph /oy/ (boy), /ir/ (girl), /ue/ (statue), /aw/ (claw) and tricky words: looked, called, asked, Mr and Mrs

In Rez and Leela's group we have been learning the blends 'fl', 'st', 'cl' and the tricky words: there, were, what, when.

We will be very busy over the next 2 weeks, so may not be doing group reading across Year 1, so will just be changing children's books during this time.
