Phonics

In Sophie's group we have been learning split digraphs u_e and e_e and revising split digraphs learnt to date.

In Sarah's group this week we have been revising Phase 5 sounds and learning the tricky words 'difficult', 'any' and 'eyes'.

In Stephanie's group we have been learning 'wh' (what) 'ph' (phone) 'ew' (new) 'oe' (toe) 'ey' (donkey) 'au' (launch) and the tricky words said, so, have, like.

In Leela's we have been learning to sound out syllables and revising 'ear', 'air' and 'oi'.

In Rez's groups we have been revising our Phase 4 blends 'bl', 'gl', 'pl' and the tricky words said, like, some, come.
