


Year One Home Learning Week 4 - 31.1.20

Phonics

In Sophie's group we have been learning the alternative pronunciation for /ea/ (meat and bread), /ow/ (owl and snow) and /ch/ (chip, school and machine). We have also been learning tricky words water, where, work, again, thought, through, who and mouse.

In Sarah's group this week we have been practising using the best bet model when spelling words with the /igh/ sound. We have also been looking at the /ch/ sound and how it presents in different words e.g. much, future, picture, catch.

In Stephanie's group we have been learning the alternative pronunciations for the graphemes 'a' and 'y'. 'a': /a/ as in splash, /ai/ as in apricot, /ar/ as in bath and /o/ as in what. 'y': /y/ as in yes, /i/ as in gym, /ee/ as in happy and /ie/ as in by. We have also been practising the tricky words: because, friend, laughed, different, many and any.

In Leela's group we have been revising our phase 4 tricky words: said, there, little. We have also learnt some phase 5 tricky words: called, looked and asked. We have learnt the 'ay' sound as in play and the 'ou' sound as in cloud.

In Rez's group we have been learning the digraph 'ay' as in stay, way, day and say. We have also been learning tricky words such as 'Mr', 'Mrs', 'Oh', 'their' and 'people'.
