- reading our topic book Tom Crean's Rabbit. We made predictions about different parts of the story, asked questions and clarified unfamiliar words.

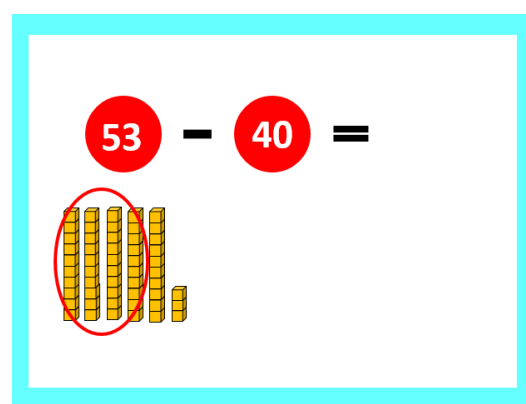
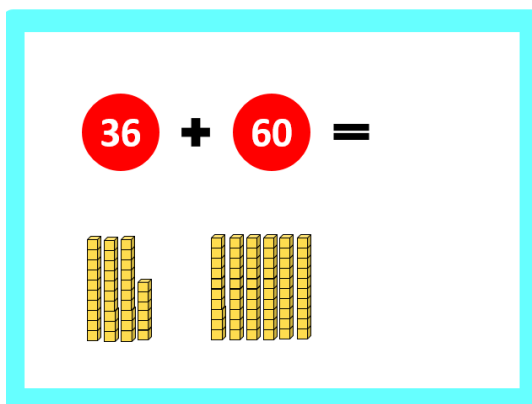


Can you clarify the following words: unravel, mutton, perched, utterly?
