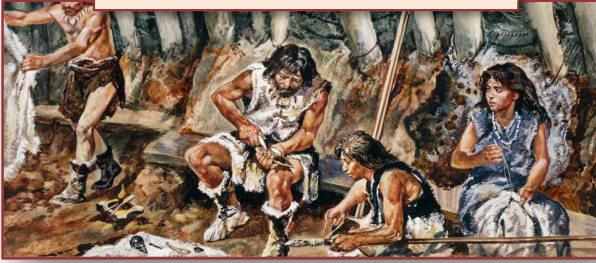

Show them which clause makes sense by itself and which doesn't.

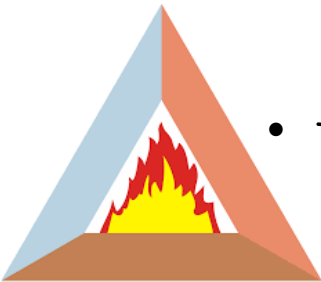
- practicing the basic skills needed to play rounders
