Phonics

In Sophie's group we have been learning the alternative pronunciation for /a/ (bath, tap, bacon, want), /y/ (yes, sky, myth, smelly), ch (chick, school, chef) and writing phase 5 tricky words learnt to date.

In Sarah's group this week we have been revising the /ai/ /ee/ and /igh/ sounds in their different graphemes.

In Stephanie's group we have been looking at alternative spellings for the /ai/ sound, for example: - game, day, aim, eight, they, apron. We have also been learning how to spell because, laugh, any, many and again.

In Leela's group we have been practising reading and identifying words beginning with 'pl' (planet/plank), 'pr' (printer/prompt), 'fl' (flower/flan) and 'fr' (fringe/frog). We have also been learning about words with more than one syllable such as 'lunchbox', 'windmill' and 'handbag'.

In Rez's group we have been learning the split digraph o-e, as in nose, rose, home and phone. We have also been reviewing our phase 3 digraphs
