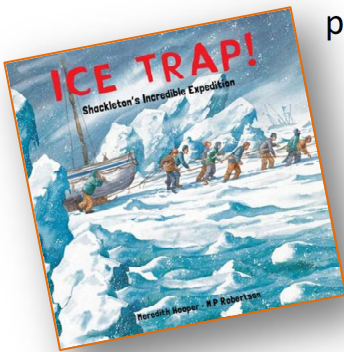


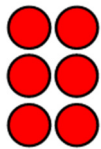
This week we have been

- reading *Ice Trap* by Meredith Hooper and learning new vocabulary to prepare us for writing our own fantastic 'Antarctic Adventure' story



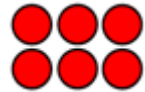
What exciting, Antarctic vocabulary can you use to summarise the beginning of the story?

These two arrays shows that $2 \times 3 = 6$ AND $3 \times 2 = 6$
Commutative means that we get the same total no matter which way round we multiply the numbers.



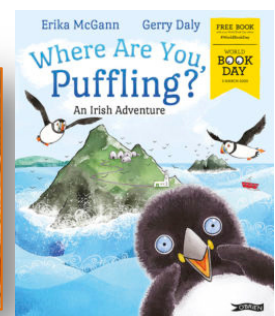
3 x 2

- enjoying our favourite books!

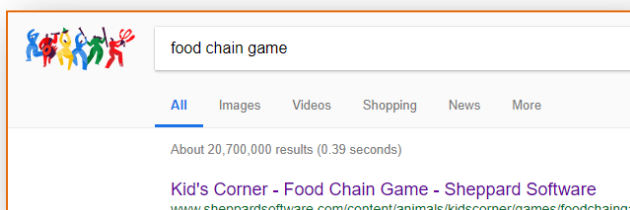
Remember that next Thursday is World Book Day
