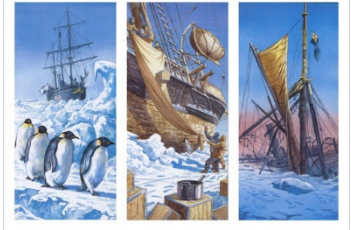

Problem solving

3 Mr Baker buys a shirt and a pair of trousers.



The total cost is £40
The shirt costs £12
How much **more** does the pair of trousers cost than the shirt?

The difference between two numbers is 15
One of the numbers is 42
What could the other number be?
