Dear Kilmorie Families,

We are at the end of another really busy week at Kilmorie. It has been wonderful to interact with so many families this week, through both the online parents` meetings (Years 1 to 6) and the International events in Reception.

Reception international event: the children thoroughly enjoyed welcoming in families to celebrate the event, which included the children performing songs they have been learning as well as families wearing traditional clothing and sharing their favourite family recipes. It was lovely seeing so many of you, thank you for being a part of it.

Assemblies: On Monday Dennis took the headteacher assemblies, his focus was that of Remembrance. With the Year 2 and Year 3 pupils he spoke about who and why we remember on the 11th of November/Remembrance Sunday.

For Years 4 to 6, he looked at this theme but with a greater focus on the contributions from the black and Asian communities and how they have been under represented in film and media. He spoke about the segregation in the American Army, culminating in the Battle of Bamber Bridge.

This morning was **Conor's Class assembly**. And what a fantastic assembly it was! The children shared their learning about Crime and Punishment, so we heard all about some of the crazy things that were done in the past to punish people. My personal favourite was the trial by cake!
