have been using this throughout activities and in conversation. We have even started to do some deep breathing! If you haven't already, take a peek at our 'Feelings' display when you're next in.

In cooking, Ashleigh and the children made pizza faces, using a bundle of colourful vegetables. And guess what? They ate them all up! So, if your children are saying, 'I don't like that vegetable', maybe ask them what they had on their pizza face at nursery!
