This week...

- We have been exploring diary entries and finding out about the common features, These include:
 - using the first person (I, me, my, mine, we, our)
 - describing events that have already happened, using the past tense
 - the writer's thoughts and feelings
 - time adverbials to link the information (next, later, after that).
- We have been learning about the Great Fire of London through the diaries of Samuel Pepys. He loved cheese so much that he rescued some from the Great Fire. What unusual items would you rescue?
- In Maths, we have been adding three 1-digit numbers. Our first step was to find the number bonds. We then added the remaining number. Draw number lines, or use your knowledge of number bonds, to find the answers.



$$3 + 8 + 7 =$$

$$5 + 4 + 6 =$$

$$14 + 8 + 6 =$$

$$17 + 4 + 3 =$$

$$26 + 5 + 4 =$$
