**Re: Year 2 Educational Visit – Dulwich College on 7<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> February 2023**

Dear Parents and Carers,

To support our learning this term about why people travelled to Antarctica and to learn more about the expeditions there, we are planning a visit to Dulwich College to see the James Caird lifeboat used by the explorer Shackleton. This should give the children some insight into what life would have been like for Shackleton and his crew during their months at sea and on land. We will be attending a guided 60-minute session on the morning of the following dates:

Sarah's Class and Kate's Class – Tuesday, 7<sup>th</sup> February

Shona's Class – Thursday, 9<sup>th</sup> February

We will be catching the 185 bus to the Horniman Museum and then the P4 to Dulwich village or we will walk from the Horniman. Weather permitting, we are hoping to combine it with a trip to Dulwich Park after lunch, where we will have some forest school type activities organised for the children. We will be leaving school at 10.00 am and will be back by the end of the school day. Your child will need a packed lunch from this trip and we will also need parent helpers for this trip. We would like parent helpers to be at school for 9.45 am. All volunteers will be informed in advance of the trip. There is no cost for the trip.

- a packed lunch unless you have ordered one in advance from the school
- any medical requirements e.g. asthma inhalers
- at least 1 drink - one of which should be a refillable water bottle
